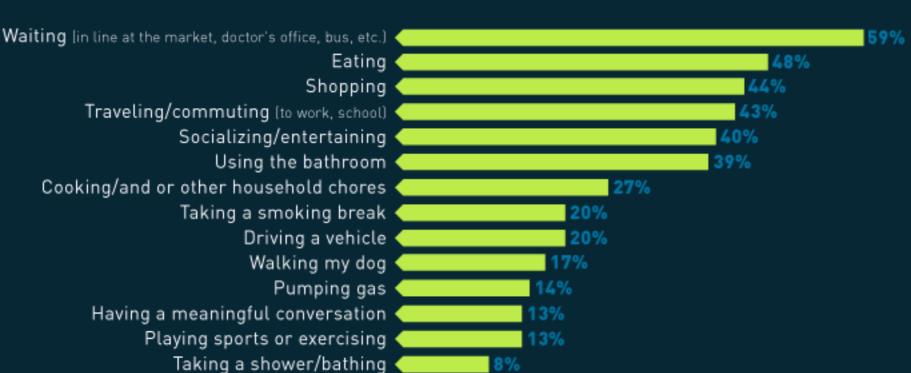

36% of smartphone users say they are willing to exchange chocolate for Internet usage on their mobile phone?

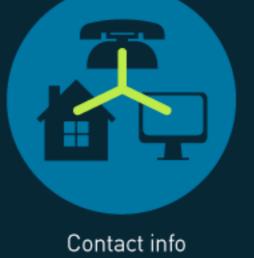
Additionally, 43% would sacrifice drinking beer and 20% are willing to give up cable TV.

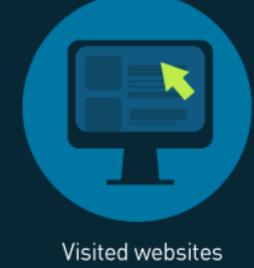

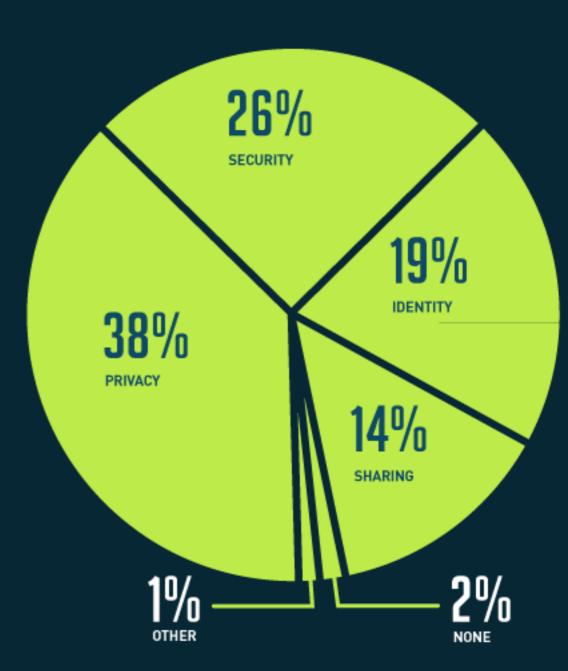
Since smartphones are being used for an endless number of activities, it is clear that users can't go long without their devices; this gives them significant reason to consider their online privacy.

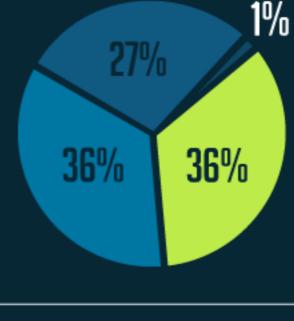

WHICH SMARTPHONES DO MOBILE USERS FEEL SAFEST WITH?

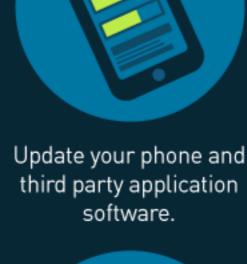

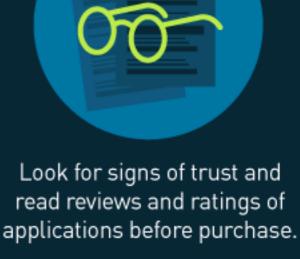
